NCRFU Match Video Policy

Home teams are responsible for recording each home match and uploading the match to the NCRFU YouTube account per guided instructions by 11:59pm local time on the Tuesday immediately following the match. This is required for all league matches and highly recommended for pre-season or friendly matches.

Failure of the home team to record or upload the match will result in a negative two (2) point sanction for that match.

Home teams must follow the below Match Video Protocol:

- The match should be recorded from an elevated angle. Field level recording should be the last possible option.
- Recording needs to be done by a digital camera recording device, mobile phones and tablets are not recommended.
- The recording should run consistently throughout the course of the match, including kicks or any time off or stoppages during the half. Half-time can be excluded.
- The recording frame should be wide to ensure the play remains within the frame.
- If a technology failure should occur, the Union must be notified the day of the match and any substitute recording (ie using a phone) should take place.
